Seasonal Flu and H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinics

HOWELL, Michigan (December 4, 2009) The Livingston County Department of Public Health (LCDPH) will be the site of two vaccination clinics next week:

- **Seasonal Flu:** Michigan Visiting Nurses will hold a Seasonal Flu vaccination clinic at the Livingston County Department of Public Health, Thursday, December 10, 2009 by appointment. Please call 517-546-9850 for an appointment. The clinic is for adults and children 9 years of age and older. The Michigan Visiting Nurses can **only** accept Medicare (Part B), Medicare Advantage Plans, Blue Care Network, Health Alliance Plan and Priority Health PPO and HMO; all of these cover the entire cost of the flu shot. Those not covered by one of those insurances can pay for the shot by cash, check or credit card; the charge for the flu shot will be \$30.
- **H1N1 Flu:** LCDPH has afternoon and evening appointments available everyday next week for the Priority Groups listed below, including children needing their second dose of H1N1 vaccine.

Please call 517-546-9850 for an appointment,

- Pregnant women,
- Persons aged 6 months to 24 years old,
- Persons who are living with or provide care for infants aged less than 6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers),
- Persons aged 25 to 64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications,
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel who have direct contact with patients,
- Children age nine and under who received their first dose of H1N1 vaccine at least 30 days ago.
